Treppner Correspondence Course – Individual Cards Explained – Part 2

At this time I will present all of the cards to you in detail, although one could certainly go on and on about the thematic cards and their meanings. For the time being, I will limit myself to the old standards, that way, the beginners will have sufficient learning material. However, the professionals among you will surely be able to come across a new tip or two. For each card, there are eight categories for their description:

1. Key Words

The terms most commonly associated with a card will be listed here. The primary meaning is written in CAPTIAL letters, making it easy to spot.

2. General Description

Here is where you'll find the description of how a card is mainly used and what you have to look out for when interpreting it. This is just an overall summary of the card—the many, smaller intricacies may only be mentioned briefly, as it would take too long to get into all of them. Also, this way you won't get too mentally overloaded.

3. Love

This category should be seen as a short question – receiving a quick answer or used for a daily overview. Sometimes multiple messages are revealed, in which case you have to filter out what is true. Because most people use the cards to ask about love, I gave this topic a brief and seperate treatment.

4. Career

This is also only a short description, dealing with possible vocation fields, as this could also turn into too much of a multilayered section. Again, this can also be used to glean quick answers or discover your daily oracle in matters relating to work and career.

5. Characteristics/Qualities

The main characteristics/qualities of a card will be addressed, so that you can get an idea what types of people can be referred to when interpreting a particular card.

6. Medicine

Under this heading, you will find the classic medical interpretations of the cards, but it is only to be used as a reference and not to replace a visit to the doctor.

7. Timing Guide

Each card carries a timing factor within it. This will be mentioned only briefly. The usage and determination of symbols referring to time will be explained later using different methods.

8. Astrological Correspondence

Astrological signs, Houses, and Planets are discussed briefly and will be dealt with later in a more detailed way in terms of the engeries and psychology involved.

NO. 1 THE HORSEMAN (The Cavalier/The Rider)

Key Words: NEWS, young man/younger man, means of transport (car, bicycle etc.), sport, business enterprises, a horse (the animal)

General Description: This card symbolizes movement and communication. A card where you get moving (in hobbies, spare time, business), get messages, you talk/converse a lot and are sociable. You have to pay attention here and there, in which direction the rider is moving and/or which card the rider is moving away from (the card to the right)., because that symbolizes a form of stagnation is to be expected. On the other hand, the card that the rider is moving towards contains a lot of dynamic energy.



Love: A flirtatious situation is going to take place, it's also possible for one to receive a declaration of love.

Career: This relates to everything in the communications field and sports – if you have applied somewhere, then you will be hired.

Characteristics/Qualities: communicative, social, athletic, young or

younger looking, well-dressed.

Medicine: Joints, tendons and ligaments **Timing Guide:** within two days – fast

Astrological Correspondence: 3rd House = self-representation

NO. 2 THE CLOVER

Key Words: LUCK and hope, but always fleeting and can change from one day to the next

General Description: The Clover is always responsible for a moment of luck; however, this is usually quite short in duration. One is nevertheless pleased about it, because it can shed light in a dark moment/emergency. It also signifies the start of short term and spontaneous business ventures.

Love: short term happiness. Sometimes something bigger can develop out of it, but not necessarily. It's rather an indication of a flirt.

Career: Call-Center, Sales, Service Industry – unexpected, on-the-job luck.

Characteristics/Qualities: merry and humorous

Medicine: Recovery from an illness. Tip: eat more food containing iron.

Timing Guide: sudden and unexpected – within four days

Astrological Correspondence: Jupiter - the planet of luck and

expansion



NO. 3 THE SHIP

Key Words: TRAVEL (airplane, train, truck, bus), foreign travel, meetings, business, independence, inheritance, longing/desire

General Description: A journey is the primary message contained within this card. This could also be a short trip or a longer term trip. At any rate, it will be memorable. In general, the card is also good for large business ventures/enterprises.

Love: One is longing for love, and this will be fulfilled if one is patient. For the short term: a romantic date will go well.

Career: self-employment, management positions, and everything that has to do with the trade and travel industries – good business is to be expected.

Characteristics/Qualities: intellectual, slender and eager to travel

Medicine: Minerals and natural salts should be preferred and natural products, in general.

Timing Guide: within three years

Astrological Correspondence: 9th House = understanding, tolerance

and expansion.

NO. 4 THE HOUSE

Key Words: HOUSE or dwelling in which one lives, property, real estate, homeland, comfort and security

General Description: Without a doubt, The House represents one's own dwelling and the message is determined by the surrounding cards, which have an impact on one's house, oneself and/or one's family. Regarding the future—if one is trying to rent or buy a house—this card is the future home and not one's current home. It represents the object of desire and one can determine if this fantasy will become reality.

Love: everything is running stably, cuddle-time is likewise to be expected or a nice candlelight dinner in a relaxing setting

Career: Craftsman, custodian, housewife, housework - and stability!

Characteristics/Qualities: the calm type, connected to one's homeland, ponderous, stay-at-home/domestically-inclined

Medicine: avoid fatty meals, consider raw foods (watch your cholesterol levels)

Timing Guide: In the morning

Astrological Correspondence: 2nd House = Security





NO. 5 THE TREE

Key Words: MEDICINE, illness and health, a longer period, growth, the process of maturity, growing up

General Description: This card is a bit boring and if you're reading cards and are sort of the spontaneous type and this card suddenly appears; then you know that for this particular inquiry they answer is going to take a long time to arrive! This card is also a general indicator of all types of medicine or diseases, especially if negative cards are combined with it (Example: Scythe, Coffin, Cross, etc.)

Love: an eternal love, but one also learn to practice some patients in regards to a particular person.

Career: Everything in the medical field – additionally, means that one may have to wait for a transfer or approval and/or may have to work harder for it.

Characteristics/Qualities: analytical, but also pessimistic and pedantic **Medicine:** spend as much time outdoors as possible – also indicates a longer lasting illness.

Timing Guide: in five years

Astrological Correspondence: Chiron – planet of the healing arts,

analysis and thriftiness/modesty

NO. 6 THE CLOUDS

Key Words: AMBIGUITY, obstacles, setbacks, despicableness, exhusband, older (more uncomfortable) gentleman, in terms of weather: rain and storms

General Description: The clouds have a dark and a light side. If the bright side of the cards is closest to a person card (Lord, Lady, Serpent, Bear, Dog, etc.), or an object card (Book, House, etc.) or a thematic card (Star, Clover, etc.), then it is a signal for the clearing up of ambiguities. If the dark side of the card is facing the person, object or thematic card, then it signifies dark times for the person, object or topic. These problems will clear up, because—as in real life, The Clouds will dissipate. However, one has to play an active role in this. If The Clouds are located above a card, then it's also seen as a negative sign, but there is no effect when The Clouds are below a card.

Love: not the best time of matters of the heart – not much is going on

Career: Research, science, technology, humanities and philosophy additionally, the clouds are responsible for rejection and setbacks on the

Characteristics/Qualities: Smoker, social drinker, slope to drugs and dependency

Medicine: Cold, flu, cough, asthma, bronchitis, pseudo-croup

Timing Guide: six years

Astrological Correspondence: Planet Neptune – for esotericism and

indistinction





NO. 7 THE SERPENT (The Snake)

Key Words: WOMAN (sister, friend, female colleague, mother etc.), a confusing path, a detour, river

General Description: This mostly refers to a woman, who should be regarded as neutral, only unless the card is paired with The Fox, which indicates deviousness or a "slippery snake". In reality, snakes are actually useful to us in nature. They exterminate parasites and this is the message imparted by this card. Confusing paths, detours and rivers are symbols – the curving form of The Serpent. Using this logic, you can also associate it with garden hoses, sewage drains and pipes of all kinds.

Love: a rivalry is possible, so watch out!

Career: Psychology, esotericism - a woman with important contacts

Characteristics/Qualities: eyeglasses, a complicated person

Medicine: Stomach and intestines Timing Guide: in seven years

Astrological Correspondence: the astrological sign: Scorpio

NO. 8 THE COFFIN

Key Words: ILLNESS, fright, negative matter, but also transformation – and through it, the process of change

General Description: If The Coffin is lying next to The House or The Horseman. As such, one has to look at The Coffin as symbolizing an illness, defect, damage, etc. Otherwise, it stand for a short fright and sometimes—when all other signs point to it—a transformation.

Love: This has nothing to do with love, but rather grief and concern, but it doesn't last long before everything is good again.

Career: Unemployment or the threat of unemployment, otherwise talent as an artist.

Characteristics/Qualities: dark type, dark thoughts, slope towards

depression

Medicine: Head area - headache and migraines

Timing Guide: immediate and negative

Astrological Correspondence: 11th House – transferrence



NO. 9 THE FLOWERS

Key Words: SURPRISE, joyful event, invitation, gift, a nice woman

General Description: one of the most beautiful of the Lenormand cards, because it's always good for a positive surprise – there's no better way to say it than that.

Love: an exciting rendezvous and romance will occur - an engagement is just as likely

Career: Job in exhibitions, art exhibits/galleries, fairs/expo - invitation to an interview or similar goes in one's favor.

Characteristics/Qualities: friendly and charming, well-maintained appearance, good taste

Medicine: get involved with alternative medicines and homeopathy. An

illness gets better **Timing Guide:** spring

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Libra

NO. 10 THE SCYTHE

Key Words: DANGER, aggression, toothache, general pain, sharp objects (scissors, knives etc.), also harvest

General Description: As with The Clouds, there is also a positive and/or a neutral or negative side to The Scythe. The left side shows the curved side of The Scythe – that is, the safe side or the side that shows that the danger has passed or will pass. Turned around, the right side of the card shows the sharp, pointed side of The Scythe is facing towards a person card (Lord, Lady, Child, Serpent, Bear, Dog, etc.), an object card (Book, House, Ring, etc.) or a thematic card (Stars, Moon, Cross, etc.). If one of these is next to The Scythe, then danger is present. If The Scythe is above or below these card, then the situation is neutral.

Love: Danger for love, jealousy and separation is possible

Career: IT, internet, webdesign – but also annoyance in the workplace and termination/leaving the job is possible

Characteristics/Qualities: aggressive, but also spontaneous **Medicine:** toothache or abdominal pains or cuts are possible

Timing Guide: autumn

Astrological Correspondence: Planet Uranus - provides for unrest and

transformation





NO.11 THE BIRCH (The Birchrod/The Whip)

Key Words: CONVERSATIONS, discussion, controversy, separation, dance, and sometimes: pairs, a broom and/or cleaning, writing utensils and signatures

General Description: The Birch is a communication card – something is going to be discuss and this discussion could get a little heavy. Sometimes The Birch indicates a separation. Birch and Letter means that something requires a signature, Birch and Ring signify two contracts, Birch and Book refer to writing and Birch and Park stand for dancing. Those are just a few of the different possibilities and combinations.

Love: Discussions about love, hopefully only passionately and not aggressively

Career: Interpreter and everything within the field of communication - annoyance on the job can arise; however, perhaps also a signature is required.

Characteristics/Qualities: thin as a pole, talkative

Medicine: Hoarseness, tonsil inflammation, sensitive throat

Timing Guide: in two years

Astrological Correspondence: 1st House – accomplishment

NO. 12 THE OWLS (The Birds)

Key Words: TELEPHONE CALLS, hectic and stress, pairs of things and sometimes an older couple (Grandmother/Grandfather

General Description: I always consider The Owls to be the telephone or contact cards, i.e. awaiting a conversation via telephone. If that doesn't apply, then it means that a hectic time of unrest and worry is on its way to you. However, it will pass. If The Child is nearby, then the effect is doubled.

Love: expect a telephone call about love

Career: Telecommunications - unrest on the job, possibly through harassment

Characteristics/Qualities: causes unrest/stressful

Medicine: high blood pressure **Timing Guide:** October

Astrological Correspondence: Venus – the planet of connections and

contracts





NO. 13 THE CHILD

Key Words: AN/YOUR ACTUAL CHILD, new start, new things (e.g. a little bit of money, extra job, attentions), young woman, sometimes a female rival, naivety, innocence

General Description: Nothing spectacular or exciting about the description, because if it's not referring to a child, then it's indicating something new or a new start —as mentioned above.

Love: a new or recent love is coming or a new start with a well-known partner

Career: all kinds of part-time jobs, otherwise everything concerning children and education. Sometimes indicates a complete change of career.

Characteristics/Qualities: childish or immature, naive

Medicine: Childhood diseases - measles, rubella, mumps, chicken

pox,etc..

Timing Guide: in short - positive

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Cancer

NO. 14 THE FOX

Key Words: FALSEHOOD, deviousness, fraud, plot, harassment, also smartness, cleverness

General Description: The Fox stands primarily for underhandedness. The Mice, The Mountain, The Coffin, etc have the ability to bring this to an end. However, if none of these cards are directly next to The Fox, then you have to watch out. If only good cards are lying around The Fox, then you can also assume that a certain thing is very clever to do.

Love: Caution! Deception in love and one has reason to be jealous.

Career: All kinds of independent work - and watch out for harassment and deviousness on the job

Characteristics/Qualities: gaunt to dry - watch out, that is a Fox! Depending upon type, either smart/clever or deceptive (usually the latter) **Medicine:** a wrong prognosis could be possible, in doubt get a second opinion

Timing Guide: December

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Sagittarius





NO. 15 THE BEAR

Key Words: OFFICIAL PERSON: Lawyer, accountant, principal, real estate broker, entrepreneur or an older person (gender neutral), possession, power, strength, envy, jealousy

General Description: First and foremost, I regard The Bear as an official. Only after that isn't at all applicable to the situation are other possibilities considered. For example, if The Bear is lying next to The House, then that signifies either a current or future possession. Together with The Lord, The Bear can refer to an emotional situation – jealousy, etc. If none of that applies, then perhaps it stands for a grandmother or grandfather.

Love: an entrepreneur could become a new or current partner - also The Bear is a reference to a jealous person or a homewrecker

Career: Entrepreneur, real estate broker, lawyer etc. The Bear is an indication of your own ability to accomplish things, which is good, if you're trying to become self-employed

Characteristics/Qualities: bubbly, effervescent – stable stature, darkblond to brown hair

Medicine: work on your internal equilibrium through yoga, meditation, etc.

Timing Guide: 10-20 years

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Aries

NO. 16 THE STARS

Key Words: ESOTERICISM and spirituality. Also: seeing clearly, good ideas and intuition, sometimes a new start or nighttime; and in terms of weather: snowflakes falling down slowly.

General Description: The Stars remind everyone of the esoteric; however, you shouldn't over-exaggerate this comparison. I've often noticed that some people always try to make such a connection, but this is rarely the case. Most of the time The Stars should be seen as a lucky card. I know that everyone wants to be esoteric, spiritual and balanced; because of this, they always want this card on their side. Of course, this could also be the meaning, just not all the time!!!

Love: a fresh start in love, this new partner could be a spiritual person and make for an exciting night

Career: Occupations in the field of esotericism – a complete change of occupation, self-employment or a total change within a company.

Characteristics/Qualities: Interest in spiritual topics **Medicine:** think about converting to a holistic way of life

Timing Guide: At night

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Pisces





NO. 17 THE STORKS

Key Words: CHANGE, transformation, relocation, travel, flexibility, revolt

General Description: There's also not that much to explain here, because mostly this is about a noticible change. Pay attention to where this card occurs. With The House, The Anchor or with The Heart? This way, you know where and how the change will happen.

Love: a positive change in love

Career: all types of creative jobs are good and it could also indicate an unusually revolutionary change on the job

unusually revolutionary change on the job

Characteristics/Qualities: colorful people, little rebels

Medicine: An illness has a positive outcome

Timing Guide: February

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Aquarius

NO. 18 THE DOG

Key Words: FRIEND, loyalty, comraderie, friendship, man, dog, domestic animals

General Description: Another harmless card that could actually stand on its own. First of all, it could stand for a friendly and helpful man. If this card is next to a person card, then it stands for a very loyal person.

Love: love develops out of friendship or vice versa

Career: Animal caretaker – and stability

Characteristics/Qualities: faithfully and friendly, mid-blond hair

Medicine: State of health will stabilize

Timing Guide: July

Astrological Correspondence: 4th House – your feelings





NO. 19 THE TOWER

Key Words: OFFICE and AUTHORITY, independence, diligence, isolation, discipline, ambition, boundaries, city limits, also separation and/or divorce

General Description: In proximity to a person, it is an indicator of independence or bureaucracy. Together with additional cards,e.g. The Bitch or Bear, it refers to a court case or negotiation. Still with other cards it stands for school, diligence or isolation. It depends on the combination, really. Sometimes The Tower shows that a person is lonely or very diligent, disciplined or ambitious.

Love: a love is lost - a separation is approaching

Career: Self-employment or occupation as a civil servant

Characteristics/Qualities: Civil servant or self-employed, slender

Medicine: Spinal Column Timing Guide: in one year

Astrological Correspondence: Planet Saturn - for boundaries and

diligence

NO. 20 THE PARK

Key Words: PUBLIC and everything in and around that: Fairs, exhibitions, meetings, society, public traffic. Additionally, a grill party or birthday with neighbors and friends, sporting events

General Description: There's not much to say about The Park that hasn't been mentioned under the key words. If you are wondering about a party or similar event, then look for The Park to see how the event will turn out. Sometimes there will be gossip, if The Owls are present or the wrong company, if The Fox is hanging around. The whole thing could be a disaster if The Coffin or The Clouds are next to it. The Clouds could symbolize that an open-air even will be rained out.

Love: You meet your new love in public (small or large event)

Career: all jobs with contact to the public

Characteristics/Qualities: is sociable, public figure

Medicine: Trip to the spa or rehabilitation measures are granted

Timing Guide: at noon

Astrological Correspondence: 7th House – meetings





NO. 21 THE MOUNTAIN

Key Words: BARRIERS, load, obstacles, protective wall, mountains, animostiy, cold weather, hill, upward, nature

General Description: Like the card says, there will be barriers. One has to look to see where The Mountain is located in order to see where the hinderance lies. Sometimes it is a burden to bear and some good could come out of it. This is especially true in combination with The Mice, who will move The Mountain if they are next to it. Yes, it's just that simple with the cards—even when The Mice are relatively small in comparison to The Mountain. In some cases, The Mountain can be seen as a protective barrier – which is good and can often be seen in terms of traveling to the mountains for holiday.

Love: love is being hindered and will not develop

Career: Mountain climber, shepher, climate researcher etc. – otherwise indicates stagnation in the workplace

Characteristics/Qualities: a cool and ponderous nature

Medicine: persisten illnes, discipline is needed

Timing Guide: January

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Capricorn

NO. 22 THE PATHS

Key Words: DECISION, alternativea, walking, open nature, road, navigation

General Description: Decision-making is the main priority of this card and it should be the first card that is interpreted. Only when the position of The Paths are such that you cannot make a decision regarding the particular topic, should you look look for alternative interpretations.

Love: one has to choose between two partners or a decision needs to be made in one's love life

Career: Part-time jobs – and a decision that works out in your favor

Characteristics/Qualities: decisive

Medicine: veins and arteries in general—a tendency towards varicose

veins.

Timing Guide: within two months

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Gemini





NO. 23 THE MICE

Key Words: LOSS, thieves, minimization, illness, parasites

General Description: By themselves, The Mice indicate that something is going to go missing soon, because they are tiny thieves. Sometimes they predict an illness, and, in rare cases, they stand for a rapid increase – this is almost never the case, however – only when The Fish (Money) are lying next to them. The Mice are a good sign, if they are next to negative cards (Clouds, Coffin, Scythe, Fox, Mountain, etc.), as they cancel out the negativity. The same thing goes for the positive cards though, e.g. Heart plus Mice = grief; Ring plus Mice = broken connection, etc.)



Love: lovesickness or the loss of a partnet

Career: Insurance, banks, team leaders - loss of one's job, being unemployed

Characteristics/Qualities: unreliable und unkempt or very nonchalant

Medicine: viruses

Timing Guide: immediate - negative

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Virgo

NO. 24 THE HEART

Key Words: LOVE, flirt, affair, affection

General Description: Once again, there are no big surprises here. This is about love. If romantic love isn't applicable, then friendship or familial love is meant. On its own, The Heart always stands for big feelings/emotions – in a large card formation, this should be one of the first cards to look out for, since one always has a lot of questions concerning love and romance. Pay attention to the surrounding cards, in order to draw your conclusions.



Love: the love of your life or love is just around the corner

Career: Independence in all areas - enthusiam about the job and putting your heart and soul into everything you do

Characteristics/Qualities: the affectionate type

Medicine: The heart **Timing Guide:** August

Astrological Correspondence: astrological sign: Leo

NO. 25 THE RING

Key Words: CONNECTION, contract, marriage, partnership, association, jewelry, circle

General Description: The Ring is another straightforward card. In most cases it is seen as a partnership/relationship or a contract – and that's just the way that it should be. The Ring in combination with The Book, The Birch, The Letter, The Anchor, etc. – indicates a business contract. Together with love, Ring – Book can stand for a secret love. It can also symbolize something that happens over and over again (in a circle). If a loved one is away and The Ring is clear of negative cards and surrounded by positive one, then it means that the person will come back, because you are still bound to them. The Ring in the card formation belongs to you.

Love: a partnership or a marriage is arranged

Career: one needs routine work - a contract arrives

Characteristics/Qualities: open to connections

Medicine: chronic suffering

Timing Guide: for all eternity or ,,not yet"

Astrological Correspondence: 8th House – searching for connections

NO. 26 THE BOOK

Key Words: SECRET, contract, education, training, re-education, seminar, a book, paper work

General Description: We're always on the lookout for secrets to reveal, but in reality, there's not that much to find out on a daily basis. Therefore, secrets should take a secondary role in our train of though. Actually, The Book can be connected with paper work/things made out of paper: letters, invoices, balances, scrips, diaries, etc. The next association is education or contracts. Depending on which cards are bordering The Book, the message can either be pleasing or depressing. If the open side of the book is facing the person card, then a secret is going to be revealed.

Love: secret love (affair) or unknown partner waits for you

Career: Scholarly situation and advanced training are good bet

Characteristics/Qualities: myster-monger, discreet

Medicine: lacking self-confidence, can manifest psychosomatically

Timing Guide: March

Astrological Correspondence: 12th House – Intuition and subconscious





NO. 27 THE LETTER

Key Words: MESSAGE – email, text message, letter, telephone call, contact, smoothness, superficiality

General Description: The symbolism of this card speaks for itself. If we are waiting for a message and want to find out if it is positive or negative, then we have to pay attention to the cards around it. The Mountain can block a message, The Mice can destory it altogether.

Love: a love letter

Career: everything within the field of media and communication – expect acceptance/approval related to the job

Characteristics/Qualities: superficial person

Medicine: one gets a prescription, which helps improvement – tendency

towards hairloss **Timing Guide:** June

Astrological Correspondence: Mercury – the planet for communication

NO. 28 THE LORD

Key Words: PRIMARY MALE PERSON CARD, male friend, married man, husband, father

General Description: In most cases, this card stands for your current partner. It doesn't always stand for the man of your dreams (the one that you really want to have, but with whom you are not together). Pay attention to the following hierarchy of cards representing males: Lord, Lily, Dog (then Bear and Horseman). This way you can get an idea of the association. If you are a man, then pay attention to this are in the card formation, because this is you.

Love: a partnership with the right man will begin soon, and/or you will make a romantic commitment

Career: Handicraft, management, self-employment - a man will become important to you on the job Sie, you will see things through

Characteristics/Qualities: male, masculine, emancipated

Medicine: male gential area, also scrapes and scratches (smaller wounds)

Timing Guide: April

Astrological Correspondence: Planet Mars – for masculine energy and

accomplishing goals





NO. 29 THE LADY

Key Words: PRIMARY FEMALE PERSON CARD, female friend, woman, wife, mother

General Description: If you are a woman, then this is your personal card. If you are a man asking about a woman, then you should look for this card first, but also remember the following cards in this sequence: Serpent, Child, and sometimes the Flower. You should remember this hierarchy, if you are not currently in a committed relationship. Otherwise, The Lady is the card for you, if you are in a partnership and can be interpreted as such.



Love: a new woman for a really good relationship is available for a man (or also a woman); for a woman, the desired form of commitment arrives (wedding).

Career: any kind of social welfare work is good – new employment contract is possible

Characteristics/Qualities: female, feminine, devoted

Medicine: hormones and female genital area

Timing Guide: May

Astrological Correspondence: Planet Venus for the connection and

NO. 30 THE LILY (is, by the way, a derivative of "holy")
